2019 Pan American Games Qualification Procedures Notification

USA Surfing is committed to sending the strongest possible team to the 2019 Pan Am Games in Lima, Peru. We believe this notification best represents how those teams will be chosen based on the information currently available to us. We are awaiting final approval of the qualification procedures from the United States Olympic Committee (USOC).

Short Board

Qualifying Events:

- 2018 International Surfing Association World Surfing Games, Tahara, Japan, September 17 – 26, 2018
- PASA Games, December 2 – 9, 2018, Lima, Peru
- The top two men and top two women from the Americas of the ISA World Surfing Games in Tahara, Japan, will earn slots in the Pan American Games
- The top six men and top 6 women from the results of the PASA Games in Lima, Peru, will earn slots in the Pan American Games.
- Maximum of two men and two women per country. ISA World Surfing Games qualifiers take precedents over PASA Games qualifiers

Long Board

Qualifying Events:

- 2019 International Surfing Association World Longboard Surfing Championships, Location and Date to Be Determined
- PASA Games, December 2 – 9, 2018, Lima, Peru
- The top man and top woman from the Americas of the 2019 ISA World Longboard Surfing Championships, will earn slots in the Pan American Games
- The top seven men and top seven women from the results of the PASA Games in Lima, Peru, will earn slots in the Pan American Games.

- Maximum of one man and one woman per country. ISA World Longboard Surfing Championships qualifiers take precedents over PASA Games qualifiers. If the ISA World Longboard Surfing Championships fails to run, an additional men's and women's longboard slot will be awarded from PASA Games results.

Stand Up Paddle Technical Race

Qualifying Events:

- 2018 International Surfing Association World SUP and Paddleboard Championships, Hainan, China, November 23 – December 1, 2018
- 2018 APP SUP World Tour, January – December 2018
- PASA Games, December 2 – 9, 2018, Lima, Peru
- The top man and top woman from the Americas of the 2019 ISA World SUP and Paddleboard Championships in the Technical Race division, will earn slots in the Pan American Games
- The top-rated man and women from the SUP Race Technical Division of the 2018 APP SUP World Tour from the Americas will earn a slot into the Pan American Games
- The top seven men and top seven women from the results of the Technical Race division of the PASA Games in Lima, Peru, will earn slots in the Pan American Games.
- Maximum of one man and one woman per country. ISA World SUP and Paddleboard Championships takes precedence over APP SUP World Tour qualifiers, and APP SUP World Tour qualifiers take precedence over PASA Games qualifiers

Surfing (Stand Up Paddle)

Qualifying Events:

- 2018 International Surfing Association World SUP and Paddleboard Championships, Hainan, China, November 23 – December 1, 2018
- PASA Games, December 2 – 9, 2018, Lima, Peru
- The top man and top woman from the Americas of the 2019 ISA World SUP and Paddleboard Championships in the SUP Surf, will earn slots into the Pan American Games
- The top seven men and top seven women from the results of the Technical Race division of the PASA Games in Lima, Peru, will earn slots in the Pan American Games.
- Maximum of one man and one woman per country. ISA World SUP and Paddleboard Championships qualifiers take precedence over PASA Games qualifiers
